Kenfrost Homes 2022 Marlin Coast Squads

11 – 17 yrs, Each Association nominates players for academy squad selection. Driven by Association Satellite Coaches & Umpires and supported by Region. Programs in 2022 include "Shooting for the Stars" and "Athlete Home Program"

Kenfrost Homes Marlin Coast Premier & Junior League

11 - 13 yrs & 14 – 17yrs. Individual athletes will be identified at Regional events to form a regionally based team/squad that will participate in either an interstate/international competition.

Kenfrost Homes Marlin Coast Netball Academy Teams

14 - 16 yrs, Individual athletes will be identified and selected at events throughout 2022

the athletes will be required to complete a home training program under the supervision of academy coaches
